

## Directions to the Post Tower

Please refer to the diagram for the location of the individual buildings

### Approaching from the North on the A555

- At the Köln-Süd motorway intersection, take the A555 towards Bonn
- At the Bonn-Nord intersection, take a right onto the A565 towards Koblenz
- Take the Bonn Poppelsdorf exit and follow the flow of traffic along Reuterstraße
- After approx. 2.5km, turn right after the Reuterbrücke (bridge) and follow the flow of traffic onto Adenauerallee (which then becomes Friedrich-Ebert-Allee)
- Turn left at the large roundabout onto Franz-Josef-Strauß-Allee (which then becomes Petra-Kelly-Allee)
- To reach the visitors' car park, take a left at the crossroads onto Charles-de-Gaulle-Straße and follow the signs to the visitors' car park
- To reach the main entrance, take a right at the crossroads onto Kurt-Schumacher-Straße and carry on until you reach the Post Tower

### Approaching from the North on the A59

- At the Köln-Heumar motorway intersection, take the A59 towards Bonn, Köln/Bonn Flughafen (airport)
- At the Bonn-Ost intersection turn right onto the A562 towards Bad Godesberg
- After crossing the Rhine, take the Bonn-Rheinaue exit and keep to the right
- Take a right onto Franz-Josef-Strauß-Allee
- To reach the visitors' car park, turn right at the second set of traffic lights onto Charles-de-Gaulle-Straße. Follow the signs to the visitors' car park
- To reach the main entrance, turn left at the second set of traffic lights onto Kurt-Schumacher-Straße and carry on until you reach the Post Tower

### Approaching from the South (Frankfurt a. Main)

- Take the A3 towards Köln (Cologne)
- Take the A560 at the Bonn/Siegburg motorway intersection
- Carry straight on at the Sankt Augustin/West intersection on the A59 towards Bonn
- At the Bonn-Ost intersection turn right onto the A562 towards Bad Godesberg
- After crossing the Rhine, take the Bonn-Rheinaue exit and keep to the right
- Take a right onto Franz-Josef-Strauß-Allee
- To reach the visitors' car park, turn right at the second set of traffic lights onto Charles-de-Gaulle-Straße. Follow the signs to the visitors' car park
- To reach the main entrance, turn left at the second set of traffic lights onto Kurt-Schumacher-Straße and carry on until you reach the Post Tower

### Approaching from the South on the B9

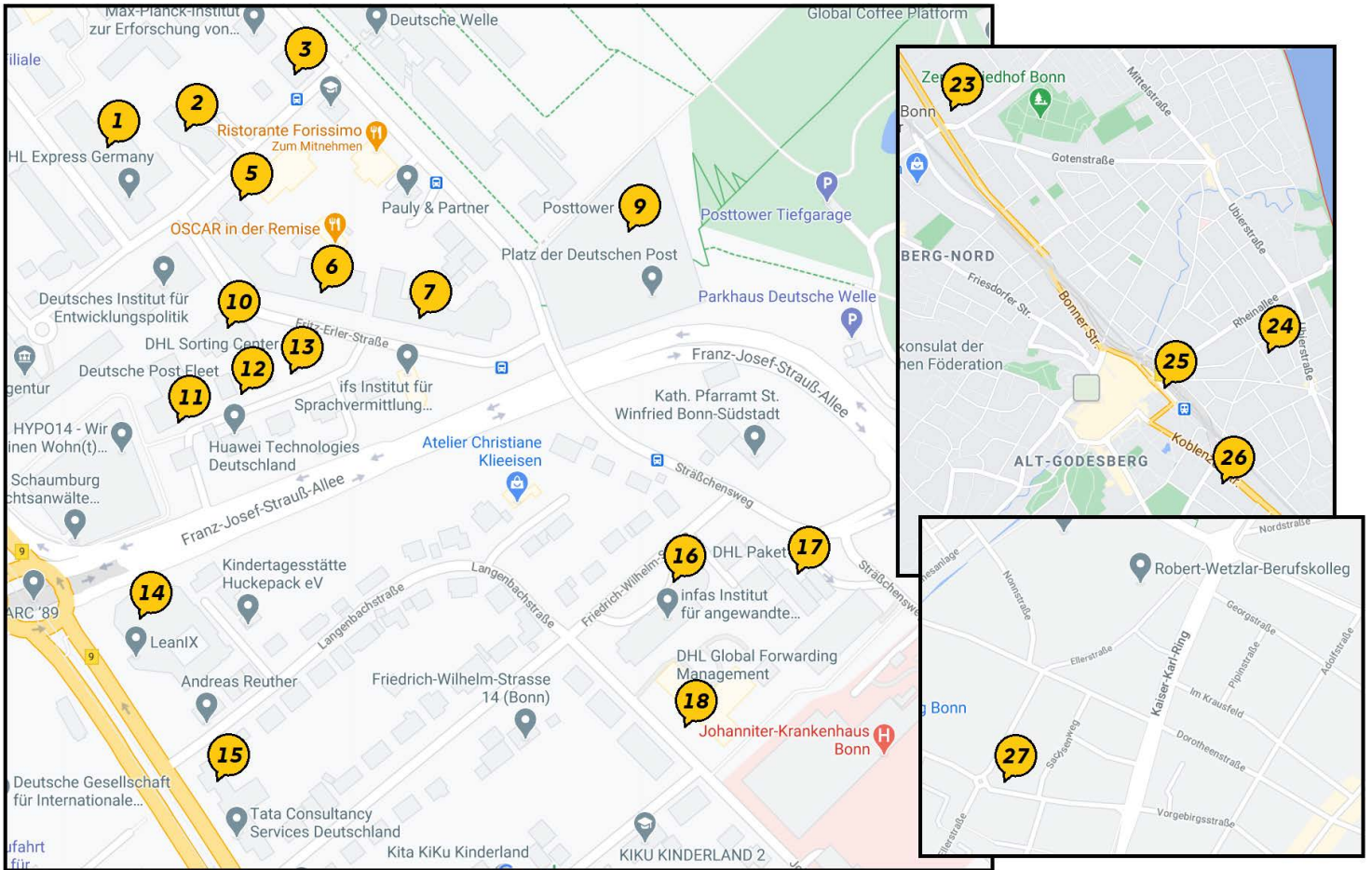
- Follow the B9
- Upon reaching the roundabout on Friedrich-Ebert-Allee, turn onto Franz-Josef-Strauß-Allee
- To reach the visitors' car park, take a left at the crossroads onto Charles-de-Gaulle-Straße and follow the signs to the visitors' car park
- To reach the main entrance, take a right at the crossroads onto Kurt-Schumacher-Straße and carry on until you reach the Post Tower

### Arriving by public transport

- Rail: Lines 16, 63 and 66 travel regularly from Hauptbahnhof Bonn (Bonn Central Station) to Heussallee/Museumsmeile; then approx. 10 mins by foot along Heussallee and Kurt-Schumacher-Straße
- Bus: The 610 bus runs regularly from Hauptbahnhof Bonn (Bonn Central Station) in the direction of Rheinallee; Bus stop: Post Tower
